


GOALS & OBJECTIVES

THINGS TO KNOW



- Labeling: Please label everything with your child's full name
- Food: If your toddler does not participate in TJB's meal program- please make sure all food is in separate containers. no glass allowed
- Clothing: Dress your child in weather appropriate, comfortable clothes for active play. We try our best to protect clothing however a messy day is a fun day.
- Daily Communication: We will share updates, photos, and notes about your child's day via Procure





THINGS TO BRING




- **Extra Clothing:** 2 full sets of weather-appropriate clothes (shirt, pants, socks) Extra shoes (optional but helpful)
- **Diapers & Wipes:** A supply of diapers & wipes (refilled as needed)
- **Diaper cream/ointments:** recommended to have on hand
- **Bedding for Nap Time:** Fitted sheet for cot, provided by TJB, extra sheets may be purchased. Small light weight blanket is needed.
- **Water bottle or sippy cup** (labeled)
- **Lunch & snacks** (if not participating in TJB's meal program)
- **Seasonal Items:** Jacket, hat, or rain boots for outside play. Sunscreen, Swimsuit & towel (for water play days)
- **Comfort Item (if needed):** Pacifier, stuffed animal, or lovey (labeled)
- **Teething necklace** is required for ALL children to have to provide comfort and minimize biting.



- **11:30–11:40** Clean Up, Transition Inside. Wash Hands
- **11:40–12:20** Lunch & Water, (Milk Bottles)
- **12:20–12:30** Afternoon Diaper Changes. Wash Hands & Faces
- **12:30–2:30** Naptime
- **2:30–2:45** Wake Up, Pick Up Cots, Snack Set Up, Pack Bags
- **2:45–3:00** Diaper Changes, Wash Hands, Afternoon Circle Time
- **3:00–3:20** Afternoon Snack & Hydration
- **3:20–4:20** Indoor/Outdoor Play, Activities
- **4:20–4:30** Evening Diaper Changes, Wash Hands
- **4:30–4:45** Outside Evening Snack (Inside when Dark out)
- **4:45–5:30** Inside or Outside Free Play/Goodbyes

LESSON PLAN






CUBBY TAGS




PROCARE APP

- Sign your child in & out of TJB using the Procure app daily.
- Daily schedules, meal & lesson plans and ALL charting (diapers/potty, meals, incidents, pictures/videos of activities) will be posted in Procure as well
- Messages regarding illness or other reports will be sent via Procure.
- Procure is also a place where you can stay in contact with teachers throughout the day. Please note that direct care takes priority. We will try to check messages several times throughout the day.







MORNING DROP OFF




- Sign your child into Procure
- Toddler drop off will be through front door in the classroom or on the Toddler yard (weather dependent)

- Please let teachers know any important information to help provide the best care for your child each





PICKUP PROCEDURES



Pick-up will also take place at this same door unless otherwise communicated. We kindly ask that all children are picked up on time. Late pick-ups may result in a late fee, as outlined in our center's policies. If someone other than a parent is picking up your child, they must present a valid photo ID, and the center director must be notified in advance. For your child's safety, we will not release a child to anyone who is not listed on the authorized pick-up form without prior approval.
