# GOALS AND OBJECTIVES

In the Wobbler class, our goal is to create a warm, nurturing environment where children can grow and thrive. We work on building social-emotional skills by helping children learn to express their needs, interact with peers, and feel safe in a consistent routine.

Our objective is to build early independence, introduce language, develop basic motor skills, and strengthen connections through play-based learning.



# Things to Know

- COT SHEETS: ARE PROVIDED AND WILL HAVE ONE READY FOR YOUR CHILD ON THEIR FIRST DAY. (EXTRAS CAN BE PURCHASED)
- MEALS: IF YOUR CHILD DOES NOT PARTICIPATE IN OUR TJB MEAL PROGRAM PLEASE SEND FOOD FROM HOME IN PLEASE USE PLASTIC, OR RUBBER CONTAINERS. GLASS CONTAINERS AND BOTTLES ARE NOT ALLOWED DUE TO LICENSING
- SHEETS AND BLANKETS WILL BE SENT HOME EVERY FRIDAY TO BE WASHED AND SHOULD BE RETURNED ON MONDAY



# THINGS TO BRING

- Blankets & Nap Items: Please bring a blanket for naptime. Sheets and blankets will be sent home every Friday to be washed and should be returned on Monday. You're welcome to include other comfort items such as pacifiers, lovey, or plush toys to help your child feel at ease during naps.
- Milk & Formula: We provide whole milk. If your child drinks a specific milk or formula, feel free to bring it from home.
- Water Cup: Please send your child with a labeled water cup each day.
- Please provide extra clothes to keep in your child's cubby
- Please bring:
  - Diapers
  - Wipes
  - Diaper cream
  - Sunscreen/Bug spray

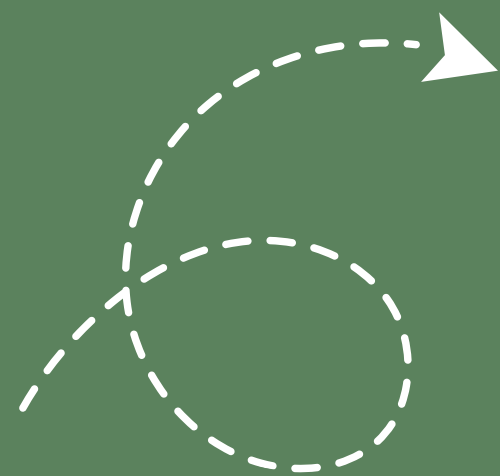


# LESSON PLAN

# CUBBIES

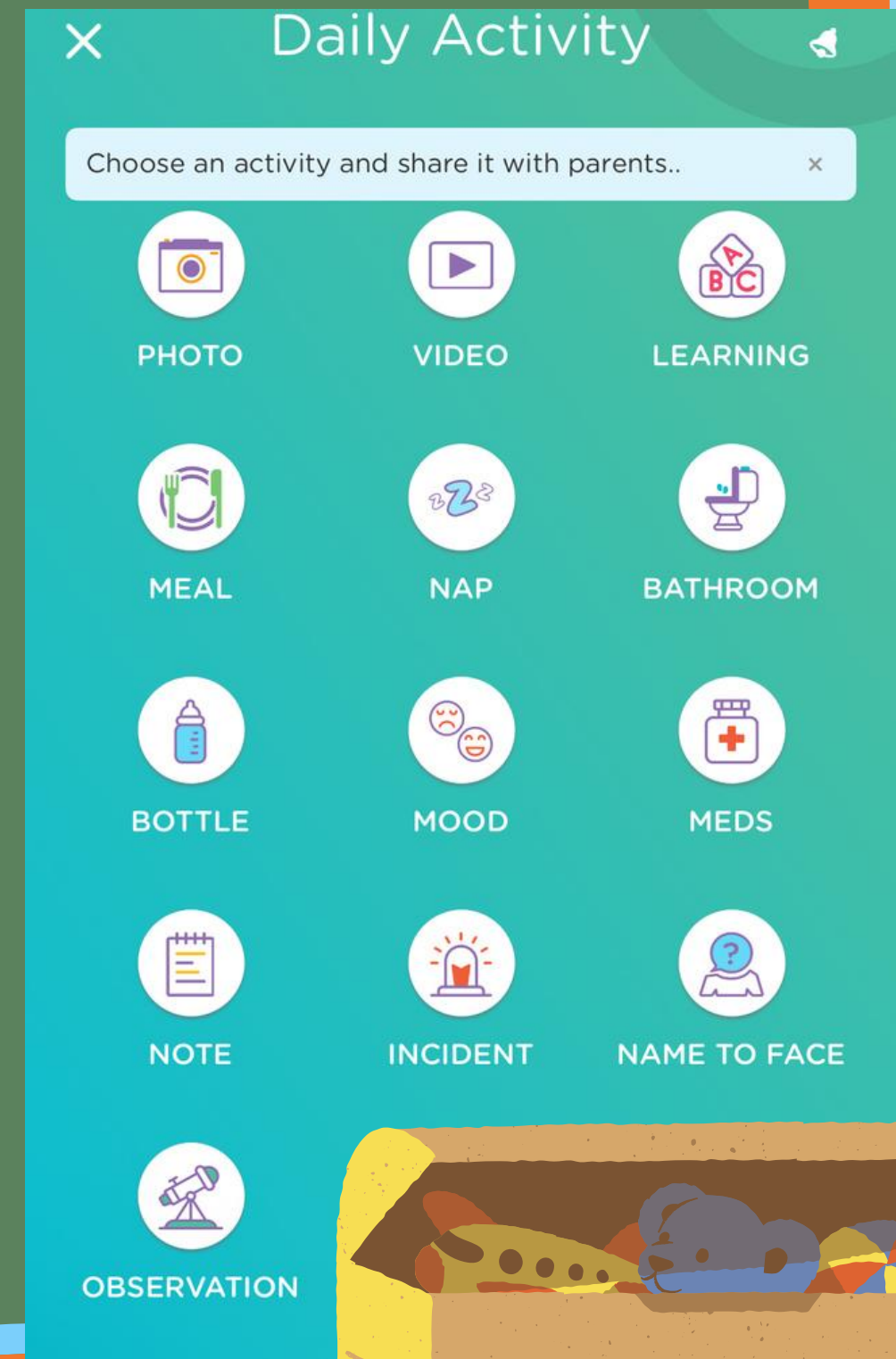
To help keep your child's belongings organized, we label their cubbies for clothing and diapers. We have plenty of room for extras so feel free to stock up!





# PROCARE

We utilize the Procare app for secure sign-in and sign-out each day. Procare is also a place where you can stay in contact with teachers throughout the day. Please note that direct care takes priority. We will try to check messages several times throughout the day. The app also allows us to share updates and photos of your child's activities, helping you stay informed and engaged in their daily experience.





# MORNING DROP-OFF

Morning drop-offs will take place at the back of the building. Once you enter TJB, please use the small side gate on the left side of the building to walk thru to the back door. Please knock, and a staff member will greet you and receive your child. Teachers will take backpacks and belongings.

Please let teachers know any important information to help provide the best care for your child including morning wake up time and last feeding.

# PICK-UP PROCEDURES

Pick-up will also take place at this same door unless otherwise communicated. We kindly ask that all children are picked up on time. Late pick-ups may result in a late fee, as outlined in our center's policies. If someone other than a parent is picking up your child, they must present a valid photo ID, and the center director must be notified in advance. For your child's safety, we will not release a child to anyone who is not listed on the authorized pick-up form without prior approval.
